FOSTER CONTRACT :

Thank you for opening your heart and home to an orphaned animal.

Listed below are regulations set forth by New Beginnings Charity regarding our foster program.

1. Foster animals are considered **the custody of New Beginnings Charity.**
2. If you are unable to continue fostering, New Beginnings Charity must be given **one month's notice** to make appropriate arrangements.
3. If you are unable to continue fostering, the fostered animal may under any circumstance, **not be** taken to other shelters, given away, or passed on to friends/family members without permission of New Beginnings Charity.
4. **Foster parents may not advertise, post photographs or network the foster pets on their own.** The photograph and details from our New Beginnings Facebook page may however be shared and networked as much as possible. This is for us to keep track of comments and have control. You may however, when sharing our photos, write your own post as long as our original photos are shared directly from our page.
5. **Fosters are not allowed to take the foster dogs/cats to our Vets on our account.** They are however welcome to take the foster pets to their own vets on their expenses. If this is not a possibility, a New Beginnings staff member should be contacted and arrangements should be made for a New Beginnings staff member or volunteer to fetch the pet and take him/her to our Vets or arrangements will be made for foster to take the pet to our vets.
6. Should you decide to adopt the animal you are fostering, our **adoption contract must be completed and the adoption fee paid when that determination is made.**
7. The foster parent is responsible for non-veterinary expenses, such as **food and litter.** (If possible)
8. New Beginnings fosters receive the following care, depending upon age:
Vaccinations
De-worming

**Sterilization on 6 months
Tick & Flea treatment**

9. New Beginnings Charity will **not be responsible for medical or ANY other expenses** incurred by the foster parent's other pets while fostering for New Beginnings.

10. **Cats must be kept indoors at all times during the day and night.**

11. Dogs may be indoor/outdoor during the day provided they have shelter, food, water and proper fencing and locked gates. **Dogs must be kept indoors at night.**

New Beginnings Charity cannot supply you with a period or time that you will be fostering the pet. Some foster parents, fosters for a few days, and others for months. It all depends on how much time it takes to find the pet a good forever home. You will have to be prepared to foster for days or months and try your utmost best to stay committed. We don't want to move our pets from one foster home to the other since that is very traumatic for a pet.

This is not a life-time commitment - it is a commitment to save one life!

FOSTER CONTRACT

I understand New Beginnings Charity does its best to evaluate a pet's temperament and behavior. I will not hold New Beginnings Charity liable for any damage the animal does. New Beginnings Charity is concerned about the health of the animals in its care and exercises due caution to prevent the transmission of diseases. Unless notified otherwise, the animals you foster have received preventive immunizations. However, due to the dire circumstances from which many of the rescue animals come, any animal may carry or had exposure to an infectious disease. New Beginnings Charity cannot warrant or guarantee the foster pet is healthy or good-natured. Any animal has the potential to bite or cause injury. Your signature below warrants your determination this animal is acceptable for you and your household to foster, and you further agree to indemnify and hold New Beginnings Charity harmless for any illness the animal may develop and any injury or damage this foster pet may cause once you have taken possession of the animal.
